An Act relative to Gold Star Family motor vehicle registration eligibility.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by inserting, after line 523, the following new paragraph:-

3 The registrar shall recognize the eligibility of the next of kin of a member of the military,
4 in possession of a Gold Star Lapel Button, under regulations prescribed by the United States
5 Secretary of Defense, to obtain a “Gold Star Family” registration plate. Proof of approval and
6 possession of a Gold Star Lapel Button, issued by the United States Department of Defense, shall
7 be sufficient proof of eligibility for the registrar to furnish a “Gold Star Family” registration
8 plate.
