An Act authorizing the town of Wayland to increase the annual spending limit for its recreation department revolving fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding clause (4) of the third paragraph of section 53E ½ of chapter  
2   44 of the General Laws, the town of Wayland is hereby authorized to expend in any 1 fiscal year  
3   from the recreation department revolving fund not more than 5 per cent of the amount raised by  
4   taxation by the town in the most recent fiscal year for which a tax rate has been certified pursuant  
5   to section 23 of chapter 59 of the General Laws. The recreation department revolving fund shall  
6   be subject to all of said section 53E ½ except said clause (4) of the third paragraph.

7           Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
