**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to sheet metal work.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 237 of chapter 112 of General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “professions”, in line 45, the
3 following words:- ; provided further, that sheet metal work shall not include the installation,
4 assembly, or integration of any water tight, pre-engineered or prefabricated metal building
5 systems, including structural members, roof systems, standing seam roofs, rib roofs or sidewall
6 systems, on or into a pre-engineered metal building structure in accordance with manufacturer
7 specifications.

8 SECTION 2. The board of examiners of sheet metal workers shall adopt rules and
9 regulations relative to the practice of sheet metal work in accordance with this act on or before
10 January 1, 2016.
