In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act relative to special education funding reform.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 24 after the word “chapter” the
3 following:—

4 Furthermore, the cost associated with and appropriated by one district shall fund all needs
5 of a child through the end of the current fiscal year should a child change school districts. Upon
6 the beginning of a new fiscal year, said new district incurs all cost henceforth.
