The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Denise Martinez, an employee of the Massachusetts Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2 Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing shall establish a sick leave bank for Denise
3 Martinez, an employee of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily
4 contribute to Denise Martinez 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank
5 for use by Denise Martinez. Whenever Denise Martinez terminates employment with the
6 department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank
7 shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for
8 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave
9 bank as determined by the department.
