An Act prohibiting a municipality or regional school district from using public funds or other public resources for the recruitment of students from outside the municipality or regional school district.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 76 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2 section 12C the following section:-

3           Section 12D. No public funds or other public resources shall be expended by a city, town  
4 or school district to recruit a student from another city, town or school district.
