2 authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of  
3 House documents numbered 286 and 295, relative to economic development matters.

5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
7 on or before December 31, 2016.
