An Act relative to testing requirements for veterans who wish to become educators.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 38G of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

The department shall provide fee waivers for any test established pursuant to this section that is required for certification as a provisional educator or provisional educator with advanced standing, provided that said test is administered to a veteran, as defined by clause Forty-third of section 7 of chapter 4.
