Frost and others for an investigation by a special commission (including members of the General Court) relative to the feasibility of hosting the Olympic Games in the Commonwealth, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2925) of Byron Rushing and others for the establishment of a Massachusetts 2024 commission on the Summer Olympic Games, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2932) of Chris Walsh for legislation to establish a disaster and emergency aid fund to ensure the safety and vitality of artists residing in the Commonwealth, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2933) of Chris Walsh and Denise Provost relative to resale royalties for artists, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 4163) ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Tourism, Arts and Cultural Development be authorized
2 to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of House
3 documents numbered 2922, 2925, 2932 and 2933, relative to tourism, arts and cultural
4 development.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study
6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
8 on or before December 31, 2016.
