In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act expanding educational opportunities for vocational students.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 62A the
2	following section:-

3	Section 62B. The provision of section 62 prohibiting a minor from operating motor
4	vehicles shall not prohibit a minor from operating a motor vehicle where such minor is enrolled
5	in a course of study and training in a vocational technical education program or a co-operative
6	education program, as defined in chapter 74, and where such minor shall be under the direct and
7	close supervision of a qualified and experienced person; and provided further that such minor has
8	been issued the appropriate license by the Massachusetts Registrar of Motor Vehicles to operate
9	a motor vehicle.
