An Act to increase public school funding in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 94C of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2   section 47A the following section:-

3           Section 47B. (a): The moneys seized through civil forfeiture shall be subjected to the  
4   following procedure(s):

5           (1) One-third of moneys seized by means of civil forfeiture as explained in section 47  
6   shall be placed directly into the Massachusetts Department of Education general fund.

7           (2) The remaining two-thirds of seized moneys will be left to be controlled as written in  
8   section 47 subsection d.

9           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, two-thousand and sixteen.
