**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for David J. Saulnier, an employee of the Middlesex Sheriff’s Office.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Middlesex Sheriff’s Office, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Middlesex Sheriff’s  
2 Office shall establish a sick leave bank for David J. Saulnier an employee of the Middlesex  
3 Sheriff’s Office. Any employee of the Middlesex Sheriff’s Office may voluntarily contribute one  
4 (1) or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by David J. Saulnier.  
5 Whenever David J. Saulnier terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the  
6 sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended  
7 illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or  
8 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the office.
