- 1 Subsection (f) of section 3 of chapter 44B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “acceptance”, in line 59, the
- 3 following words:- initially and on each quinquennial anniversary.
