The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act to support schools and communities to increase opportunities for physical activity.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71 of Section 71, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding the following
2 subsections

3 Definitions:

4 Community Based Organization-means a public or private nonprofit organization of
5 demonstrated effectiveness that—

6 (A) is representative of a community or significant segments of a community; and

7 (B) provides educational or related services to individuals in the community

8 Non-service hours-hours that are defined and posted by the community based
9 organizations when the public facilities are not in use by their programs or any subsidiaries of
10 said Community Based Organization

11 Except as provided in this section, a school district [and school personnel] [is/are] not
12 liable for any loss or injury arising from the use of indoor or outdoor school property and
13 facilities made available for public recreation or sport during non-school hours. Nothing in this
14 section limits the liability of a school district [and school personnel] for willful or malicious
15 failure to guard or warn against a dangerous condition, use, structure or activity; or acts or
16 omissions constituting gross, willful or wanton negligence.

17 Except as provided in this section, a community based organization as defined by as
18 defined above [and community organization personnel] [is/are] not liable for any loss or injury
19 arising from the use of outdoor property and facilities made available for public recreation or
20 sport during non-service hours
