**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to special education funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of section 5A of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 44 the number "4"
3 and inserting in place thereof the number "3"; and further by striking in line 51 the number "4"
4 and inserting in place thereof the number "3."
