An Act relative to school threats.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1.
- 2 Section 2A of chapter 148 as so appearing in the 2012 Official Edition is hereby repealed
- 3 and the following new section inserted in its place:-
- 4 Section 2A. The principal of any public or private school that provides instruction to
- 5 pupils in any of grades 1 to 12, inclusive, shall immediately report any incident involving the
- 6 unauthorized ignition of any fire, or other threats made to persons or property involving,
- 7 explosives, biological hazards, shootings or other threats of any kind, including cyber threats, to
- 8 the appropriate local police or fire departments. In the case of a fire, the principal shall submit a
- 9 written report of the incident to the chief of the fire department within 24 hours on a form
- furnished by the department of fire services. The report shall be filed without regard to the
- extent of the fire or whether there was a response made by the fire department. The head of the

- fire department shall report any incident of unauthorized ignition of fire to the marshal in accordance with section 2.
- Section 2. Section 37L of chapter 71 as so appearing in the official edition is hereby amended by inserting after the word "fires" in line 4, the following words:- or other threats
