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**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**  
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An Act authorizing the town of Huntington to grant one additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1.(a) Notwithstanding section 17 of said chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2           licensing authority of the town of Huntington may grant one additional license for the sale of all  
3           alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 15 of said chapter 138 to  
4           B and L Bridge Store LLC, dba/Bridge Store Packy located at 3 East Main Street, Huntington,  
5           Massachusetts, and shall be subject to such requirements and conditions as the licensing  
6           authority shall deem appropriate. The license shall be subject to all of said chapter 138, except  
7           said section 17.

8           (b) The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other  
9           location but it may grant the license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files  
10          with the licensing authority a letter from the department of revenue and the department of  
11          unemployment assistance indicating that the license is in good standing with those departments  
12          and that all applicable taxes, fees, and contributions have been paid.

13           (c) If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use at the  
14 location of original issuance, it shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges  
15 and restrictions pertaining thereto, to the licensing authority which may then grant the license to  
16 the same location under the same terms and conditions specified in this act.

17           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
