The committee on Environment, Natural Resources and Agriculture to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 642) of Nick Collins relative to the development and promulgation of regulations governing underground storage tanks; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 648) of Stephen L. DiNatale and others relative to certain fee exemptions under the toxics use reduction act; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 681) of Colleen M. Garry relative to communities being granted Brownsfields Assessment and Remediation Funds, notwithstanding the participation of the Regional Planning Organization; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3554) of Chris Walsh for legislation to prohibit the application of herbicides within five hundred feet of a residence, school or playground; reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 4651) ought to be adopted.

1           *Ordered*, That the committee on Environment, Natural Resources and Agriculture be  
2 authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of  
3 House documents numbered 642, 648, 681 and 3554, relative to toxic management.

4           Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study  
5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
7 on or before December 31, 2016.
