Ehrlich relative to the reclamation of land after surface mining has concluded operations; petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 662) of Lori A. Ehrlich relative to the groundwater survey program; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 715) of Jay D. 1           *Ordered,* That the committee on Environment, Natural Resources and Agriculture be  
2 authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of  
3 House documents numbered 660, 661, 662 and 715, relative to land policy.

4           Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study  
5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
7 on or before December 31, 2016.
