Calter relative to protecting the diversion of water from the central water district of Plymouth County; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 640) of Nick Collins for legislation to limit the number of special use permits that the Department of Conservation and Recreation may issue requiring the closure of all or a portion of Columbia Road or Day Boulevard; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 746) of Angelo M. Scaccia and David Hodgdon that the Department of Conservation and Recreation be directed to perform regular review and maintenance of the Neponset River in the city of Boston; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 747) of Angelo M. Scaccia and David Hodgdon relative to the maintenance of certain footpaths and trails at the Blue Hills Reservation and the Neponset Reservation; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 766) of Walter F. Timilty and others relative to the protection of property owned by the Commonwealth and part of the Blue Hills Reservation referred to as Fowl Meadow; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 767) of Walter F. Timilty and Angelo M. Scaccia relative to the protection of property owned by the Commonwealth and part of the Blue Hill Reservation referred to as Fowl Meadow; reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 4667) ought to be adopted.
