DiNatale and Benjamin Swan relative to solid waste disposal facilities; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 739) of Denise Provost and others for legislation to reduce plastic bag use through regulations and incentives; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 768) of Walter F. Timilty relative to permit applications for non-hazardous waste transfer stations; reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 4669) ought to be adopted.
