2 authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of
3 House document numbered 4617, relative to An Act relative to licenses for the sale for all
4 alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises in the town of Wareham.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study
6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
8 on or before December 31, 2016.
