In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act concerning media literacy in schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of Section 1 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is
- 2 hereby amended by adding the following sentence: The Department of Elementary and
- 3 Secondary Education shall encourage school districts to implement instruction in media literacy
- 4 skills at all grade levels, and in any of the core subjects or other subjects, to equip students with
- 5 the knowledge and skills for accessing, analyzing, evaluating, and creating all types of media.
