An Act expanding the special education reimbursement program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5A of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, after the word “include,” in line 26, the words
- 3 “transportation costs”.
