An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Alicia Harmon, an employee of the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Massachusetts  
2   Rehabilitation Commission shall establish a sick leave bank for Alicia Harmon, an employee of  
3   the Commission. Any employee of the Commission may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,  
4   personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Alicia Harmon. Whenever Alicia  
5   Harmon terminates employment with the Commission or requests to dissolve the sick leave  
6   bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave  
7   bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability  
8   that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Commission.
