An Act authorizing the Three Rivers Fire District to continue the employment of Michael Matthieu.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Michael  
2   Matthieu, a firefighter with the Three Rivers Fire Department, may continue in his position until  
3   March 31, 2018; provided, however, that Michael Matthieu is mentally and physically capable of  
4   performing the duties of the position. If requested, Michael Matthieu shall, at the expense of the  
5   fire district, be examined by an impartial physician designated by the prudential committee to  
6   determine his capacity. No further deductions shall be made from the regular compensation of  
7   Michael Matthieu pursuant to chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service subsequent to  
8   March 31, 2017 and upon retirement Michael Matthieu shall receive a superannuation retirement  
9   allowance equal to that which he would have been entitled had he retired on March 31, 2017.

10           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
