An Act authorizing the town of Leyden to continue employment of police chief Daniel J. Galvis.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Daniel J. Galvis, chief of
- 2 police of the Town of Leyden, may continue to serve in that position until he reached the age of
- 3 70, or until the date of his retirement or non-reappointment, whichever occurs first.
