**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to regional school transportation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. SECTION 2E of Chapter 131 of the Acts of 2010 is hereby amended by
2 adding at the end the following:

3 Regional School Transportation shall not be lowered by 9C cuts of the Governor, but
4 rather by vote of the Legislature. Further, any reductions made by the legislature shall not be
5 greater than the percentage reduction in Chapter 70 school aid.
