An Act relative to the regional school transportation reimbursement fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 16C of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end the following sentence:
  
- 3           “Reimbursements made by the Department and deposited in the Regional School
- 4   Transportation Reimbursement Fund may carry forward for one fiscal year.”
