In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act relative to the powers and duties of a regional school district.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 16 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:-

3 (s) A regional school district may serve as the fiscal agent when the regional district and
4 one or more towns or superintendency union have hired the same superintendent and central
5 office staff; provided that the regional district shall enter into a written agreement with the school
6 committee or committees concerning the regional district billing the school committee or
7 committees for services and payment of personnel.
