Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
2 Chapter 210 of the acts of 2014, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “any political
