An Act relative to the Division of Waterways to dredge Quincy Bay.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 91 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, by adding the  
2 following section:-

3 Section 64. The director of the division of waterways in the department of environmental  
4 quality engineering shall dredge the natural channel that exists between the Squantum Yacht  
5 Club, the Wollaston Yacht Club and Quincy Bay. The channel serves as a designated emergency  
6 route for evacuation by the United States Coast Guard and is used for the expedited transfer of  
7 Quincy Bay accident victims to medical treatment facilities.
