An Act relative to application of pesticides in municipalities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 132B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following words:  
3 "Nothing herein, nor any regulation issued by the Massachusetts Department of Agricultural  
4 Resources, shall preclude any city or town from requiring, prior to any application of pesticide  
5 within that city or town, a hearing to determine whether a proposed application of pesticides in  
6 particular locations will be consistent with the product’s labeling, other restrictions imposed by  
7 the Pesticide Board or its subcommittees, and whether the applicant is proposing to use particular  
8 pesticides only as permitted by law.”
