An Act designating a certain area in the Dorchester section of the city of Boston in memory of Trooper Mark S. Charbonnier and Deputy Sheriff Sgt. Richard "Ricky" Dever.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The Department of Conservation and Recreation shall designate a certain area along the  
2 Neponset River in Dorchester in the memory of Trooper S. Charbonnier and Deputy Sheriff Sgt.  
3 Richard "Ricky" Dever. The area shall be on Department controlled property at the Neponset II  
4 Park, Pope John Paul II Park or the surrounding area. The Department shall consult with the  
5 Dever and Charbonnier Families to design, erect, and maintain a suitable marker that may  
6 include but is not limited to an overlook, bench, flagpole, kiosk, or memorial stone.
