## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to solid waste disposal facilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 150A of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the 18th paragraph the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- 4 Nothing in this section shall be deemed to prevent or restrict a city or town from enacting
- 5 or enforcing zoning ordinance or by laws pursuant to chapter 40A or any other authorizing
- 6 statutes which ordinances or by-laws are applicable to landfills, transfer stations, recycling
- 7 centers and sanitary waste disposal sites provided that such ordinances or by-laws do not prevent
- 8 closure activities, maintenance activities or assessment activities which are necessary to protect
- 9 the public health, public safety or the environment as determined by the department based on
- 10 substantial evidence.
