In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to noise pollution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of Chapter 21A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 4 after the word "regulation," the

- 4 which shall include, but not be limited to, low-frequency noise, infrasound and
- 5 aerodynamic amplitude modulation,
