#### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to health insurance coverage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 "Section 63. Health insurer providers shall be prohibited from canceling coverage for
- 3 non-payment until the insured is a full 90 days late with premium payments. Said providers shall
- 4 reinstate coverage if the insured pays the premiums in arrears. Said providers shall not deny
- 5 reinstatement to the insured once the premiums in arrears are paid.".
