An Act to preserve the competitiveness of group auto insurance plans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 193R of chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out in item (7) of the eighth paragraph therein the words “and that at least thirty-five  
3 percent are insured within two years of the effective date of the plan, such percentage to continue  
4 so insured at all times thereafter”.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on passage.
