An Act relative to access to health insurance for human service providers and their employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 (b) of chapter 32A, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by adding after the words "of Suffolk county," in line 16, the following:-  
3           "person who is employed by private human service providers that deliver human and  
4 social services under contracts with departments within the executive office of health and human  
5 services and the executive office of elder affairs,"
