An Act to provide for tobacco cessation benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 17K the following section:-

4           Section 17L. The commission shall provide to any active or retired employee of the  
5 commonwealth who is insured under the group insurance commission a smoking and tobacco  
6 use cessation treatment benefit. Smoking and tobacco use cessation treatment and information  
7 benefits shall include nicotine replacement therapy, other evidence-based pharmacologic aids to  
8 quitting smoking, and accompanying counseling by a physician, certified tobacco use cessation  
9 counselor, or other qualified clinician.
