Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

  Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (5) the following:
- 8 (6) resources in an amount determined annually in accordance with 42 U.S.C. §1395w-9 114(a)(3), the criteria used for a Medicare Part D low- income subsidy for individuals with 10 income up to 150 percent of the federal poverty level.
- The division shall file for any necessary waiver, amend its state plan to the extent required by law and promulgate regulations to implement said resource exemption.
