**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to the definition of sole community provider.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8A of Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out the definition of “sole community provider”
3 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

4 “Sole community provider”, any acute hospital which qualifies as a sole community
5 provider under Medicare regulations or under regulations promulgated by the executive office.
6 Those regulations shall consider factors including, but not limited to, isolated location, weather
7 conditions, travel conditions, percentage of Medicare, Medicaid and free care provided and the
8 absence of other reasonably accessible hospitals in the area; provided, that such hospitals shall
9 include those which are located more than 20 miles driving distance from other such hospitals in
10 the commonwealth and which provide services for at least 60 per cent of their primary service
11 area.
