*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the  
2   phrase "duties assigned to them" in line 248 the following:- "employees of the town of Amherst  
3   working as Emergency Dispatchers;"
