An Act to allow the town of Dedham to participate in lease negotiations with DCAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the legislative body of the  
2 town of Dedham may discuss lease negotiations with the department of capital and asset  
3 management and maintenance for a period of 10 years. Such discussions shall be conducted on  
4 behalf of the Norfolk county district attorney’s office for the purpose of relocating said district  
5 attorney’s office within the town of Dedham.
