By Mr. Collins of Boston, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 7B) of Nick Collins that the city of Boston be authorized to issue two additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises. Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure.

**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act authorizing the city of Boston to issue additional liquor licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
2 licensing authority of the city of Boston may grant: 1 additional license for the sale of all
3 alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 12 of said chapter 138 to
4 Western Host, Inc. d/b/a Element Hotel, located at 391-401 D Street in the city of Boston; and 1
5 additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises pursuant to
6 section 12 of said chapter 138 to Western Host, Inc. d/b/a Aloft Hotel, located at 401-403 D
7 Street in the city of Boston. The licenses shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except section
8 17.

9 The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of any of the licenses to any other
10 location but it may grant a license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files
11 with the licensing authority a letter from the department of revenue indicating that the license is
12 in good standing with the department and that all applicable taxes have been paid.

13 If any license granted pursuant to this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it
14 shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining
15 thereto, to the licensing authority, which may then grant the license to a new applicant at the
16 same location under the same conditions as specified in this act.
