### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act concerning the tax status of property of a housing authority.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	Section 16 of chapter 121B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official
2	Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
3	The property of an instrumentality or entity created or designated by a housing authority
4	in order to participate in the rehabilitation, repair, development or redevelopment of low and
5	moderate income housing undertaken or assisted pursuant to local, state or federal legislation or
6	resources, including a state or federal low income housing tax credit program, shall be deemed to
7	be public property used for essential public and governmental purposes and shall be entitled to a
8	tax exemption in the same manner as the housing authority under this section, and shall be
9	entitled to make payments in lieu of taxes as provided in this section.
