Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of section 15 of chapter 85 of the General Laws, as appearing in

2 chapter 481 of the Acts of 2014, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following

3 language :the words "A penalty under this section shall not be a surchargeable offense under

4 section 113B of chapter 175."
