An Act relative to license to carry fees for active duty law enforcement officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 131 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 436, the following words:- active and.

3           SECTION 2. Paragraph (i) of said section 131 of said chapter 140, as so appearing, is  
4 hereby amended by inserting after the ninth sentence the following sentence:- For active duty  
5 law enforcement officers, or local, state, or federal government entities acting on their behalf,  
6 there shall be no fee for the application.
