Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of Chapter 527 of the Acts of 1983 is hereby amended by striking out the word
2 “four” in subsection (iii) of the definition of “Housing accommodation” and inserting in place
3 thereof: “three”
