An Act relative to the celebration of Halloween.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Great and General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts shall establish that
- 2 the last Saturday in October annually be designated as the celebration of Halloween,
- 3 recommending that the people carry out appropriate celebrations on said day.
